Instructions:

1. No. = number herd cases consecutively through the program.
2. If you do individual casework, those cases should be logged on the ABVP Case Log used for food animal, equine, companion animal and avian.
3. Date = date of initial exam.
4. Client complaint = brief description of perceived problem.
5. Diagnosis = your final diagnosis of actual problem.
6. Economic Significance = briefly indicate impact of clients problem or farm finances.
7. Recommended Changes = briefly describe or list your recommendations.
8. Herd Monitoring = briefly list steps to monitor the herd after your recommendations are implemented to see if improvement occurs.
